Fresno Pacific University is a fully accredited Christian liberal arts college beautifully situated in southeast Fresno, California, offering undergraduate degrees in music and other majors, as well as Masters degrees in a growing number of fields.

The Fresno Pacific Summer Music Camp offers senior high, junior high and middle school students the opportunity to study with outstanding Fresno Pacific University music faculty, music students, and other Central Valley professional musicians for a week of intensive music-making and learning about music. While the serious study of music is our major concern, we seek the development of personal responsibility, including effective practice habits, respect for one another, and conceptual learning, as opposed to mere rote learning.

The Camp is open to all students entering 6th through 12th grades (ages 11-19 as of September 1, 2009) who are interested in continuing their musical studies this summer. Programs are offered in INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC, STRINGS, VOICE, PIANO,

CONTEMPORARY WORSHIP and HANDBELLS. There are also electives available in jazz, chamber ensembles, music & drama, and original music composition.

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC: The instrumental program offers opportunities for rehearsal and performance in a wind ensemble, directed by Dr. Patricia DeBenedetto and Jeff Jacox as well as small group instruction on all wind and brass instruments.

STRINGS: Dr. Dieter Wulforth and Dr. Susan Doering join us this summer to direct our String Ensemble and offer master classes.

VOICE: Under the leadership of Melinda Ramos, vocal students will participate in daily instruction and rehearsal in solos and choirs, several numbers of which will be presented on the final concerts.

PIANO: Master classes with Arlene Steffen, Dr. Walter Saul and assistants each day will help students to study, analyze, and perform solo piano and chamber music.

CONTEMPORARY WORSHIP TEAM will be directed by Milton Friesen. Students will be guided in a team of worship leading in contemporary styles.

(NEW IN 2009!) HANDBELL CHOIR with Beth Gonzales will improve rhythm skills and provide a cooperative and fun music experience.

ELECTIVES are Jazz, Chamber Music, Composition, and Musical Theater. Please choose one on the attached Application Form.

SCHEDULE: Arrive Sunday, June 21, 2009, 3:00-4:30 PM. Final Concerts: Thursday, June 25, 2009, 7:00pm, and Friday, June 26, 2009, 2:00 PM. Day campers arrive at 8:35am and depart at 5:00pm each day but may return in the evening for camp activities.

Fees for Summer 2009:

Resident Camper (tuition, room, board, insurance): \$475.

Day Camper (tuition, insurance): \$275.

Resident Camper, Early Bird: \$450.

Day Camper, Early Bird: \$250.

For siblings: the first camper enrolled pays the full fee; the second and subsequent siblings attending together may take a 10% discount off their fees.

Requirements for application: Complete and detach the adjacent application form. Mail it with a *letter of recommendation* from your music teacher, private instructor, church music director, etc. and a *nonrefundable \$50.00 deposit*. To qualify for Early Bird rates, enclose a check for \$250 for a resident camper, or \$150 for a day camper, by **June 1, 2009**. **All amounts paid are nonrefundable!**

Scholarships: a number of \$125 Day Camper and \$225 Resident Camper scholarships will be awarded via application. Camp staff reserves the right to split scholarship awards and distribute them over the Instrumental Music, Strings, Voice, Piano, and Contemporary Worship Team programs to ensure a balanced representation in all programs.

To apply for a scholarship: Check the appropriate box on the application form. Enclose with your application (or send later) a *CD or cassette tape* of your performance of two short contrasting pieces of no more than seven minutes total duration. **All CD's must be postmarked by June 1, 2009.** Please note that we cannot process any applications for scholarships without a completed application form and a \$50.00 deposit. **Thanks to Music Teachers Association of California-Fresno Branch, we have scholarships available for applications of MTAC-Fresno students submitted by May 1, 2009. Get yours in now to qualify.**
