A **married student** should add about \$3,000 for a non-student spouse and \$3,000 for each child. (This includes health insurance costs for a spouse and child which are significantly higher than \$820.)

Health insurance information: Cost for insurance depends on the **starting session** as follows:

Sessions 1 and 2: \$820
 Sessions 3 and 4: \$470
 Summer session: \$140
