Historical note

The Board of Christian Education of the General Conference of Mennonite Brethren Churches coordinated and directed conference work in Sunday schools, youth programs, Vacation Bible Schools, mid-week programs, worker training programs, camps and church libraries. It also published adult Sunday school instructional materials for the conference, the *Adult Quarterly* and the *Lektionsheft*.

The first mention of a board of this kind appears in the proceedings of the 1924 MB General Conference, under the name *Sonntagsschulkomitee*. The committee did not report to the conference again until 1936. Beginning in 1939 the board reported regularly to the conference, under several different names: *Komitee für Sonntagsschule und Religiöse Erziehung* (1939), Sunday School Committee (1943-1948), Church Schools Committee (1951-1972) and Board of Christian Education (1975-1990). At the 1990 General Conference the Board was subsumed under the new Board of Resource Ministries (Record Group A225).
