

Transfer Scholar Award Q&A

The information below applies to traditional undergraduate transfer students who have been offered a Transfer Scholar Award that entitles you to a unique leadership program opportunity. The information below is valid for Transfer Scholars who transfer into the traditional undergraduate program during the 2011-2012 academic year.

What is the Transfer Scholar Award?

Congratulations on your high academic achievement! You have received a Transfer Scholar Award as a part of your financial aid award package in recognition of your achievement. The Transfer Scholar Award recognizes incoming transfer students who have excelled academically and demonstrated leadership potential. This award is not only an academic scholarship, but also includes a special course on developing leadership skills. This scholarship is renewable for up to three years while you complete your degree at FPU.

What is required of me as a Transfer Scholar?

As a Transfer Scholar you must maintain a 3.0 FPU cumulative GPA. You must also register in a transfer leadership class where you will be challenged to grow in your role as a leader on the FPU campus and in your community. You will learn about various leadership models, develop your strengths as a leader and expand the strengths that you already have.
