Intensive English Learning

International students need good English skills to succeed in undergraduate studies. Students meeting academic requirements but without a sufficient TOEFL score (at least 500 and 50 in each section), will be required to participate in the Intensive English Language Program (IELP). Students may earn up to 16 units of credit through IELP applicable as electives to the bachelor's degree.

Currently, FPU offers 26 majors in more than 45 areas of study through the School of Business, the School of Natural Sciences, the School of Education, and the School of Humanities, Religion and Social Sciences.
