Application and Admission Information

To be considered for admission, please submit the following items:

- Completed Application for Admission**
fpu.edu/applygrad
- Official college/university transcript(s)** verifying receipt of a bachelor's degree in kinesiology, physical education or a related area from a regionally accredited institution and any post baccalaureate work.
 - If you are currently finishing up your degree, please submit current transcript.
 - A final transcript will need to be submitted before you may enroll in classes.
 - Individuals without a bachelor's degree in kinesiology or a related area may satisfy this requirement one of the following ways:
 - Having a minimum of 12 semester units of prerequisite study in kinesiology, physical education or a related area (not including PE activity units or athletic participation units).
 - Four years of full-time or eight years of part-time physical education teaching and/or coaching experience.*
 - Combination of academic and work experience equivalent to 12 semester units of pre-requisite coursework.*

- If your cumulative GPA for your bachelor's degree is below a 2.75 (4.0 scale), a letter of explanation is required.
- Reference Form** – One reference is required for the Kinesiology: Physical Education program. The reference should attest to your professional qualities and your academic qualifications, noting your ability to complete graduate-level work.
 - Form can be found at fpu.edu/graduate-reference
- Statement of Intent** – Provide a written statement explaining your interest in the program, long-term goals and your experience in the field.
- International applicants** must submit additional documentation including English Proficiency Score (TOEFL=minimum of 550 PBT or 79 iBT, IELTS=6.5), copy of passport, visa information and a statement of financial support.

*One year of full-time physical education teaching and/or coaching experience = 3 units of pre-requisite coursework. One year of part-time physical education teaching and/or coaching experience = 1.5 units of pre-requisite coursework.
