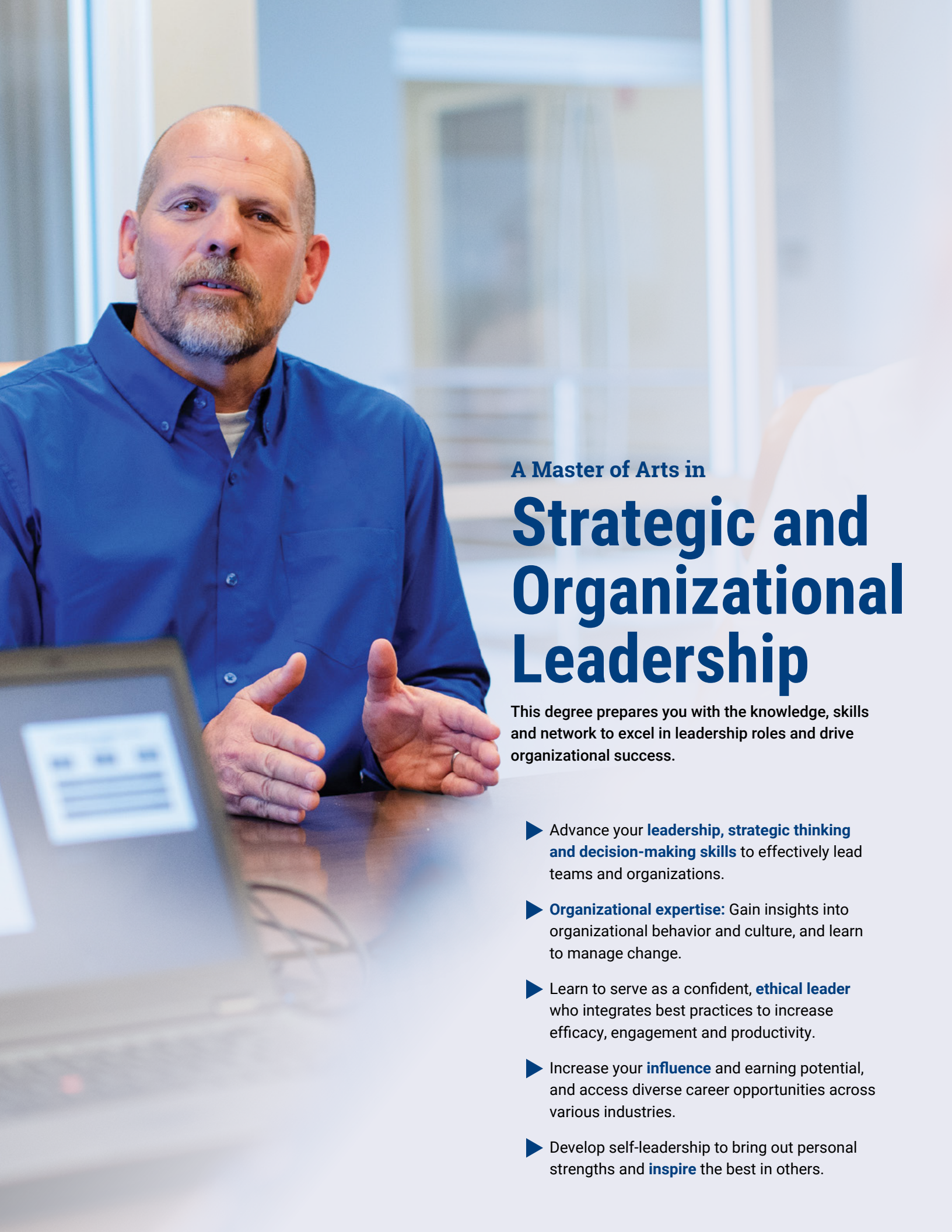

- ☐ If your cumulative GPA for your bachelor's degree is below a 3.0 (4.0 scale), a letter of explanation, an academic reference and a statement of intent is required.
- ☐ **Resume** – Submit a personal resume detailing your work experience.
- ☐ **International applicants** must submit additional documentation including English Proficiency Score (TOEFL=minimum of 550 PBT or 79 iBT, IELTS=6.5), copy of passport, visa information and a statement of financial support.
