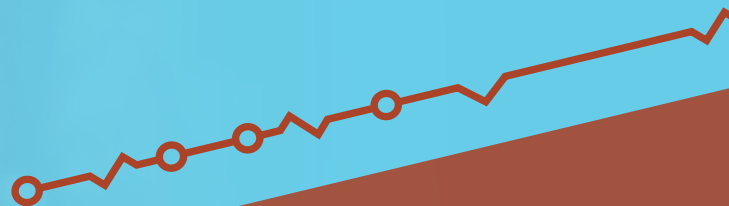
- ▶ **Problem-Solving Skills:** Develop analytical abilities to tackle complex issues within the justice system.
