FPU Program Highlights

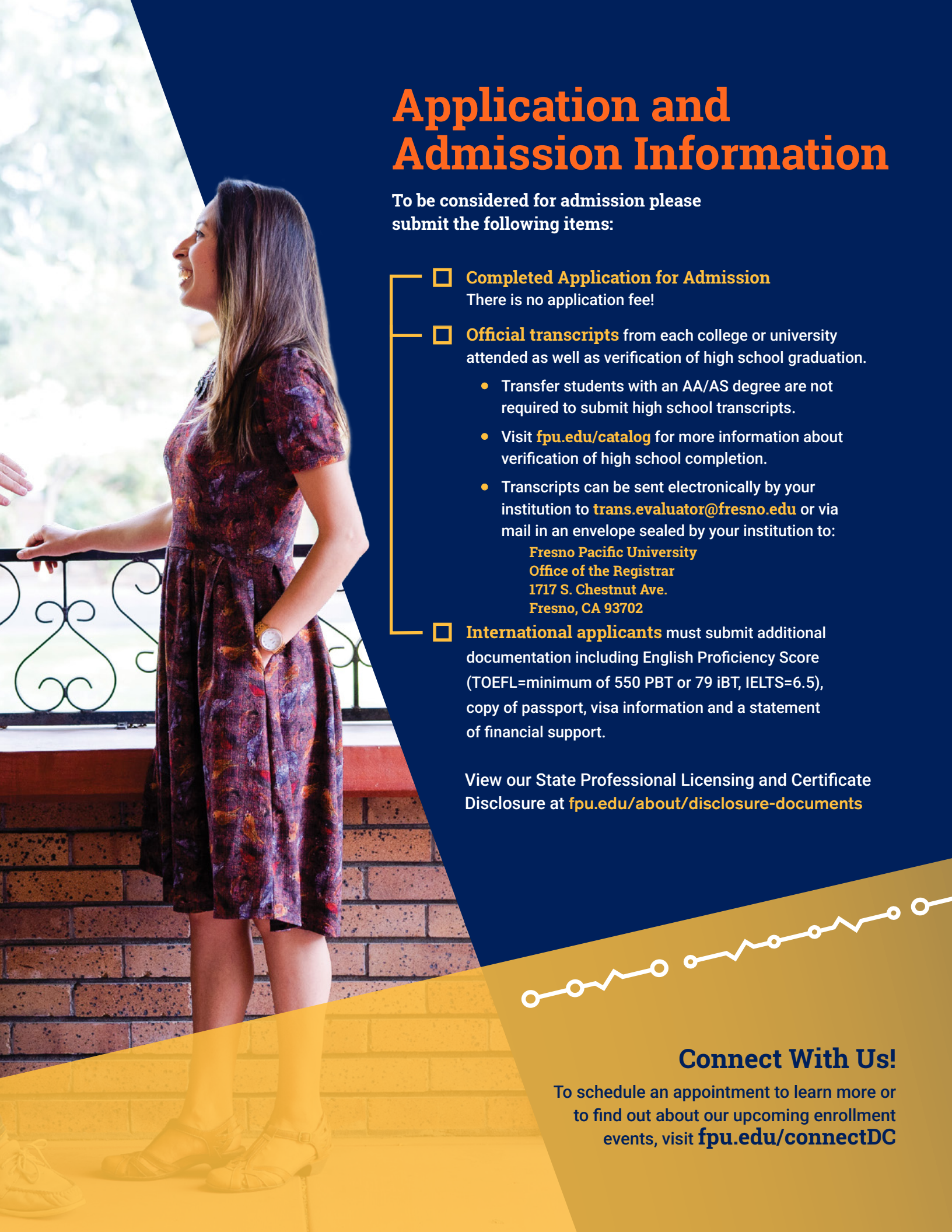
