
Application and Admission Information

To be considered for admission to the M.A. in Christian Ministry, please submit the following items:

- Completed Application for Admission**
fpu.edu/applysem.
- Official college/university transcript(s)** verifying receipt of a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution and any post baccalaureate work.
 - If you are currently finishing up your degree, please submit the current transcript.
 - A final transcript must be submitted before you enroll in classes.
 - If you have not completed a bachelor's degree and are applying for special admittance, send all official collegiate transcripts if applicable.
 - Transcripts can be sent electronically by your institution to trans.evaluator@fresno.edu or via mail in an envelope sealed by your institution to:

- If your cumulative GPA** for your bachelor's degree is below a 2.5 GPA (4.0 scale), a letter of explanation is required.
- Reference Forms** - Two references are required for the M.A. in Christian Ministry. One should be from a spiritual mentor, and one should attest to your academic qualifications, noting your ability to complete graduate-level work.
 - Form can be found at fpu.edu/sem-ref
- Writing Sample:** Submit a writing sample from your undergraduate education; this can be any paper submitted for a letter grade regardless of subject.
- International applicants must submit additional documentation including English Proficiency Score (TOEFL=minimum of 550 PBT or 79 iBT, IELTS=6.5), certified transcripts through an FPU approved service, copy of passport, visa information, and a statement of financial support.
