## Note-Taking Assistance

- Student Responsibilities:
  - Attend class daily
  - o Make arrangements for a note-taker
    - Ask a classmate to assist, or
    - Ask the professor to help identify a willing, capable volunteer
    - Work out details for note-sharing system.
      - Bring carbonless paper/notebook to class if needed.
      - Take your own notes as much as possible.
- Professor Responsibilities:
  - o If requested by student, help identify a willing, capable volunteer:
    - Make a classroom announcement that a note-taker is needed, or
    - Make a request of a known student to take notes.
      - Do not announce the name of the student requiring assistance to the whole class!
- Things to Keep in Mind
  - o The student is responsible for his/her own learning.
    - Another student's notes are a supplement not a substitution for the student's in-class learning.
  - o SSD office will supply carbonless paper for easy note-sharing if needed.
