



Next Step Checklist for Admitted Degree Completion Students

Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- The FAFSA is the application for Federal and State aid program which includes loans and grants. FPU uses the information on the FAFSA to determine your financial aid package, including student loans. All students are encouraged to apply.
- The FAFSA can be completed by visiting www.fafsa.gov. **Please use the FPU school code 001253 or we will not have access to your information.**
- California residents: **March 2 is the deadline to submit the FAFSA to be eligible for the Cal Grant program.** There is no deadline for annual Federal programs.
